Subject: Retaining of access codes and telephone numbers for Airports being shifted to a nearby place using the same airport code

It has been brought to notice that recently new Airport has been commissioned at Devanhalli near Bangalore which is away from Bangalore SDCA but uses the same Airport code which was being used by the old Bangalore Airport.

2. Keeping in view the public interest at large and convenience of the customers worldwide, the undersigned has been directed to convey the approval of the competent authority that whenever an Airport has closed for public use at one place and shifted to a nearby place using the same airport code, the telephone numbers and access codes should not be changed and the operators are allowed to use the old access code and telephone numbers at the new premises.
