**Minutes of Meeting**

**Subject: 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting of the core committee -Minutes thereof.**

The 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting of the core committee was held on 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2011 at 15.00 hrs at 11<sup>th</sup> floor, in the chamber of DDG NT, Sanchar Bhawan. It was attended by the members of core committee including special invitee from BSNL. Shri N Ram, Director (NT), DoT welcomed all the participants.

Director (NT) started the discussion after a brief about the progress till date after the 2<sup>nd</sup> core committee meeting. It was discussed at length about the flow and contents to be delivered in the awareness workshops being conducted by BSNL across the country. Sh. R P Singh, DGM ALTTC, BSNL was asked to decide the flow and content for the workshops and have a panel of the speakers (3-4) for topic wise. It was decided that the flow of the topics can be IPv6 Policy and action taken so far, Why IPv6, Features of IPv6, Application of IPv6, Global adoption status and migration issues, Case study on the application of the IPv6.

Further discussions were as below:-

**i. Articles for India IPv6 Task Force newsletter –**

It was informed that fourth issue of India IPv6 Task Force newsletter is ready to release but to make further issue more informative all members were requested to contribute with articles on IPv6 and its applications. It was agreed that all will try to send articles for the coming issue which is due in February, 2012. It was also discussed that despite assurance no one has send any article on it other than Mr. Naveen from TCL who has in turn complied the issue 4 in coordination with Mr. Srinivas from M/s Neosixth. Mr.

Ravindra Singh from Tech Mahindra and Mr. Anup Pandey said that they will send articles positively for the issue 5.

ii. **FAQ already uploaded on DoT/TEC website to be reviewed and further FAQ to be added.**

FAQ received from ALTTC, BSNL in 2<sup>nd</sup> core committee was send to Director (I) TEC to upload the same on the website. New FAQ was also received from Mr. Naveen Dhar from TCL was discussed in the meeting and it was decided to forward the same to director (I) TEC to compile and cross check with the existing one and upload on the website accordingly.

**Others points discussed were as follows:**

1. All ISPs should make it clear that how customer can get IPv6 address/ address block from ISP and it was suggested that all ISP can be asked to make available this information on the main page of their website. It was reported that ISPs are doing needful in this regards.
2. GM (BB), & DGM, ALTTC BSNL was asked to prepare some of the case studies for the IPv6 Low Pan applications, which can be prepared in consultation with IISc, IITs and other reputed institute as they have done some of the project in this regard, same was reviewed but the progress was not satisfactory and requested to BSNL that needful should be done at the earliest.  
Mr. Anup Pandey from CISCO said that he will prepare a project plan in one of the field encompassing all the features like planning, equipment, budgeting, benefits etc. in Indian atmosphere and send to the NT cell within next 15 days and will be discussed in the next core committee meeting.
3. Mr. Raman Agarwal, Addl. GM, BSNL, CO was asked to prepare the list of vendors encompassing all fields mobile, fixed application etc. and arrange to organize one meeting in DoT at the earliest. He was asked to prepare a list in the first case within a week and discuss the same with DDG (NT) for further action. it was also decided to hold fist meeting with Vendors in the second week of January on 10th or 11<sup>th</sup> Jan, 2012.

4. All the Presentation and newsletter can also be uploaded on the BSNL website---- progress in this regard is still awaited from BSNL.
5. As per the actionable point of the oversight committee meeting held on 4<sup>th</sup> October, 2011, the focused group constitution was approved by the competent authority consisting of members from IISc, IIT Kanpur & Mumbai, IPv6 world forum, TCL, Airtel and NAv6 Malaysia etc. for providing technical help to the core committee as and when needed.

The meeting ended with the vote of thanks.
