<p>2.2 (d)(ii) The LICENSEE shall ensure that the Radio Transmitters used while deploying wireless system(s) are located and established at a distance of 10 KMs from the international border of India, and such radio transmitters will work in such a fashion that any signal or signals, emanating therefrom, fade out when nearing or about to cross international border and also become unusable within a reasonable distance across such border.</p> <p>41.9 The LICENSEE shall ensure that the Radio Transmitters used while deploying wireless system(s) are located and established at a distance of 10 KMs from the international border of India, and such radio transmitters will work in such a fashion that any signal or signals, emanating therefrom, fade out when nearing or about to cross international border and also become unusable within a reasonable distance across such border.</p>	<p>2.2(d) (ii) For provision of mobile services in areas falling near International Border of India, the condition specified in clause 41.9 shall be applicable.</p> <p>41.9(i) There shall be a “No Service Zone” of 500 Meters width along the International border within Indian territory for wireless/ mobile service, where the Licensee(s) are not permitted to provide wireless/ mobile service. The Licensee shall use requisite technology to ensure that the signals become unusable within 500 Meters of International boundaries and there shall be no wireless/ mobile service in the “No Service Zone”.</p> <p>41.9(ii) The Licensee shall create a “Buffer Zone” of 10 KMs width along the Line of Control (LOC), Line of Actual Control (LAC), Akhnoor and Pathankot areas in J&K, as applicable, wherein they shall not deploy their Cell site(s)/ BTS(s)/ Radio Transmitter(s).</p> <p>41.9(iii) Periodic surprise checks may be carried out by the Licensor or its authorized representative(s) including security agencies in order to ensure compliance of the above conditions by Licensee(s). In case, any violation in respect of usable mobile signals in the “No Service Zone” and/ or deployment of Cell site(s)/ BTS(s)/ Radio Transmitter(s) in the “Buffer Zone” are detected, stern action will be taken according to the terms and conditions of the License Agreement, including imposition of financial penalty.</p>
